

## Additional Information

The workshop will consist of 3 Stations (Concepts, Traditions and Steps); each participant will spend 20 minutes at each station. At the end of the time each station will give a brief overview of the information learned at their station.

o Vote on a name for the AIS and Literature Distribution Center. o Begin electing trusted servants for various service positions. o Set a timetable for goals to be achieved.
