District Meeting Minutes—March 10, 2018

District 4 Meeting Minutes
 March 10, 2018
 Hosted by Spring Branch Club

The meeting opened with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer. The Traditions, Concepts and Warranties from the Al-Anon/Alateen Service Manual were read.

The following reports were given:

Secretary – In Renee’s absence, Linda F. recorded the meeting discussion as well as took notes. Carol reminded everyone that the Minutes from prior meetings would be published in The Light and should be reviewed prior to our District Meeting to save time. One correction to the Minutes was requested by Barbara and that was to change the date on #7 for the Intergroup meeting to the 29th. Bev made a motion to accept the Minutes as corrected, and Josh 2nd. Passed by acclamation.

Treasurer – Delia made a motion to accept the Treasurer’s Report, 2nd by Barbara. Linda F. reported that she had incurred expenses from ordering new checks with the new address and a stamp for deposit information.

Mattie provided an expense receipt and request for reimbursement from the last quarter of 2017. Because the books were closed for 2017, the Treasurer needed approval from the Group to pay this expense. After discussion, Barbara made a motion to pay this expense and adjust the books accordingly, 2nd by Laura. Passed by acclamation. Treasurer brought a request for the District to determine a policy for reimbursement of expenses. After discussion, Motion was made by _____ to reimburse expenses within 90 days from the date the expense was incurred, 2nd Laura. Motion carried.

Alternative DR/Literature: Sheri B. advised everyone

that the new Service Manual was online and free to be downloaded to your electronic devices.

Alateen Coordinator: Mattie announced that the Sugarland Alateen Group had closed for now. Josh advised he was unable to attend Posse.

Outreach- Pam reported on attending a local health fair and was looking for other opportunities to put Al-Anon and Alateen in visible areas. Bev reported on a group that has formed in Brazoria County that consists of some judges and two Al-Anons, Bev and Sheri D. Bev described it as a type of “town hall” meeting to educate judges and those in the legal system about AA, Al-Non, Alateen. The Judiciary has formed a “Drug Court” that is seeking solutions for offenders that is not mainstream jail and not sending people to AA or Al-Anon as a punitive action. Bev shared that the requirements of “Drug Court” are very tough.

Intergroup – Barbara reported that the Intergroup offices would be moving to different offices in the same building to cut down on expenses. Their meetings are the 4th Sunday of each month at Chapelwood Methodist Church, Houston.

Newsletter – Laura B. is our new publisher of the Light and she needs all reports NO LATER THAN MAY 26, 2018!!

New Business:

A representative from Bay Area Club was present and advised it their wish to change from District 5 to District 4. Carol will continue to have discussions about this change. They have Al-Anon, Alateen and AA meetings. On Saturday they have an Al-Anon meeting from 10-11:15. They meet at 2111 Webster Street, League City, TX.

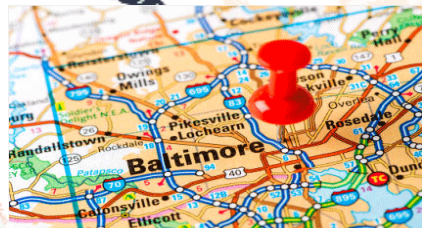
