I'll be attending the next AWSC meeting Saturday, August 24, in Schertz, TX (near San Antonio). <u>Public Outreach</u>: Pam reported success in getting publications into Fort Bend libraries. She also attended the Ft. Bend Symposium and stated the need for business cards to hand to mental health attendees. Brazoria and Galveston Counties also hold Coalition meetings every month. Sue is following up on Brazoria County.

Sue contacted the Pearland Neighborhood Center and they are willing to display Al-Anon pamphlets.

Rosario asked if there was Spanish Translation available for A Day In Al-Anon. Sue is following up.

<u>Old Business</u>: We are partnering with District 3 for the November Assembly. AF Groups need to bring baskets. Sherri and Teresa are doing a skit. It will be held November 1-3 in Victoria, Tx.

<u>2019 Day in Al-Anon</u>: Besides Spanish translation needed. Joyce brought up the ease of using "Square" and offered her assistance for streamlining literature sales and registration. Sue will follow up with Joyce, Linda and Pam.

<u>New Business</u>: Carol mentioned some districts are using conference calls for dist. Meetings, at least for those who cannot attend. Carol will check into this and provide an update at the next district meeting.


