

AWSC Report – November 7, 2020

District 2 currently has two Zoom accounts and all our meetings have gone virtual. We have kept them the same day and time as their original face-to-face meetings. Recently, we added one in-person meeting out on Padre Island. One group has both in-person and Zoom meeting attendance. Most members have gotten used to the virtual meetings and have asked to keep several of them available when we return to in-person meetings because of the flexibility to attend additional meetings and see many fellow district members.

We had our quarterly District Meeting virtually on June 7, 2020 and conducted a workshop on Zoom meeting features like GR's being able to claim host rights during meetings and welcoming newcomers, getting literature to members, etc. There was discussion about groups opening online payment accounts for contributions, but currently members are mailing contributions to the individual group's treasurer.
