

Delegate Airline Ticket Credit

The change in venue for the World Service Conference (WSC) from a face to face meeting to a virtual platform one month prior to the WSC resulted in the current Delegate (Kay C.) having a non-transferrable flight credit of \$590.20. The flight credit expires December 31, 2021. The flight arrangements are made by WSO so WSO has invited the Texas East Area to determine how to make use of this flight credit, whether it be in service to Al-Anon in Texas East or inviting Kay to use it for her personal use as a thank you. An example of use in the Area would be to fly to Baton Rouge in March to attend the South Central Regional Delegate Meeting. The immediate past Delegate (which Kay will be) expenses are paid for by the Area so this would help defray the immediate past Delegates expenses. Kay would not fly to the Assembly in District 9 or District 13 due to where she lives. Another use for the ticket credit is that Kay could also use the ticket credit to attend the Road Trip in Cleveland Ohio in 2021 or the Al-Anon 75th Birthday party in NY in April. Kay would be representing the Area at these events.
