The 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarterly SAAIS meeting met at Schertz United Methodist Church on Saturday, 24 April. It was hosted by the Pass It On Al-Anon Family Group, who we thank for their hospitality. It was attended by 15 representatives of their personal AFG's, thirteen (13) voting at this meeting.

All reports were accepted as written. It was voted to take the Speaker Meeting back to Club 12 beginning 05 June 2021, where all speakers and attendees will be in person. No more virtual or hybrid Speaker Meetings. Club 12 has the Al-Anon room ready for Speaker Meetings to begin in person again.

The Answering Service and Website Coordinator are working together, along with Lynn S, District Representative, to keep updating the meeting lists. It is working much better than in the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic but has room for continued improvement.

It was also voted to share a ZOOM PRO account with District 12 for one year at the cost of \$61.50 each group. Only one meeting can occur at a time and it is only for one year. Details for keeping track of meetings and training people to host ZOOM meetings will be worked out soon. That information will be sent later. It was felt that if a virus or COVID-19 got worse again, we would be prepared this time.

The seed money of \$1000 given to District 12 to host the Fall Serenity Celebration 2020 was returned to the SAAIS. The SAAIS voted to have the next Serenity Celebration in Fall 2022 due to the lack of time in which to plan one for any earlier.

Our last item of business was to elect a new Chair for the SAAIS, as I have resigned due to health issues with my husband and myself. We had two (2) candidates from which to choose, and Tony A. is now the new SAAIS Chair.

Thank you to everyone in the District and SAAIS for your support and sharing during meetings. They have been full of information and opinions, yet it was always "Principles Before Personalities" I appreciate all of you for making this an exciting and educational experience for me.

### HOSTING A QUARTERLY DISTRICT MEETING

The proposed Quarterly District Business Meetings dates in 2021 are:

July 17 – All Day Meeting (Morning District Business Session/Lunch Break/Fall Assembly Committee Meeting until approximately 4 PM)

October 16 – All Day Meeting (Morning District Business Session/Lunch Break/Final Prep for November Fall Assembly until approximately 4 PM)

### What Is Required from the Group Hosting?

1. A place to meet (hopefully your home group meeting place) that will accommodate up to 35 people, and tables and chairs for those attending\*.
2. Members from the host group willing to volunteer their time to set up the meeting space, welcome attendees and clean up at the conclusion of the meeting.

### What is generally covered by, but not expected of, the Group Hosting the meeting?

1. Coffee, water, juice, condiments and breakfast snacks
2. Cups, paper plates, napkins and the necessary utensils (forks, knives, spoons)
3. A space that offers kitchen facilities – sink, refrigerator, sufficient electrical outlets (only needed if this is an all-day session where lunch may become a factor) Keep in mind that the attendees are responsible for their own lunch be it potluck or brown bag.

### What expenses would be covered by the District?

1. Cost of the rental of the facility.

### What other work does the Group have to do?

1. Nothing unless you want to. All mailings/flyers will be generated from the District so there will be no additional expenses.
