District 7 was pleased to be able to host the Area World Service Committee (AWSC) meeting on January 29 at the Dobbin Community Center near Montgomery. We provided lunch, beverages, audio/visual equipment and hospitality volunteers. With the sale of remaining framed slogans and book covers left over from the 2020 Fall Assembly and donations from those present, we came in under budget for the event. It was a successful, well attended meeting on a beautiful day.

District 7 now has five certified AMIAS, two of whom attended POSSE in March in Gonzales. Their expenses were covered by the District. The Woodlands Al-Ateen group continues to be well attended. Another meeting may be formed in the future, possibly in Bryan or Magnolia.

There are currently 29 active groups in District 7 and 33 meetings. Most groups are back in person or hybrid. We are working to increase communications and attendance at District meetings with phone calls, District Facebook page posts and a Weekly Update email bulletin that members may share at their meetings. District meetings continue to be hybrid and include a drawing for a door prize such as a Forum subscription and guest speakers. Lynn B., Area Archives Coordinator, will be the guest at the July 16 meeting and our Area Delegate, Mattie T., will be the speaker at the October 15 meeting.
